



Day 1: Meet and explore Gua Musang


14:30 hrs: Meet at Muse Eco Park or Gua Musang Train Station, where your adventure begins. Your guide, along with fellow explorers, will be waiting for you.

14:45 hrs: Check-in to your accommodation, an elegant homestay with hotel-style comfort – each room is a master bedroom, equipped with air-conditioning and ensuite bathroom with water heater. Enjoy a little rest after the long drive.

15:00 hrs: Hop into a van and take a slow spin around Gua Musang. Visit Kampong Pulai and go on a short hike to a limestone outcrop with a Goddess of Mercy temple within. Learn why there is a Hakka Chinese settlement here from 600 years ago.

18:00 hrs: Adjourn to a nearby eatery offering authentic local food for an early dinner.

19:00 hrs: Return back to homestay. Free & easy time.





Day 2: Nature galore in Taman Negara

07:30hrs: Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at a beloved local eatery. Try the Kelantanese version of nasi kerabu.


08:15 hrs: Head to Taman Negara, entering via one of its lesser known entrance, Sungai Relau in Merapoh.

08:45 hrs: Transfer to a 4WD vehicle and your exploration of the country's largest protected forest begins.

O9:15 hrs: A local expert will introduce you to the world of birds. Grab a pair of binoculars and spot some avian species that call Taman Negara home.

10:00 hrs: Explore the Treetop Walk. Soak in the views and learn about the rich ecosystem of different layers of the forest.

11:00 hrs: Follow a local wildlife tracker as he hunts for animal paw prints on a trail used by mammals to traverse the jungle.





Day 2: Nature galore in Taman Negara

12:30hrs: Savour a riverside picnic lunch at Kuala Juram Fish Sanctuary, a hidden aquatic retreat deep within the forest.


13:15hrs: Indulge in a bit of healing & chilling in the pristine river. Play with the fishes, meditate or just take a nap!

14:00 hrs: Enjoy an easy guided hike to a secluded spot for wild swimming

15:30 hrs: Hop back onto the jeep and visit Menara Seraya for panoramic vistas of the vast rainforest canopy. On a clear day, the highest peak in Peninsular Malaysia, Gunung Tahan is visible.

16:30 hrs: Exit Taman Negara and on the way back, climb up a viewpoint for a panoramic view of Merapoh's landscape.

18:00 hrs: Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.





Day 3: Caves and Farewell

07:30 hrs: Breakfast followed by a van transfer to Merapoh.


08:30hrs: Embark on a half-day jeep excursion:

Venture into Merapoh's ancient limestone caves (220 - 350 million years old), where you will be captivated by their geological significance.

Meet Amin the "Batman", a dedicated bat researcher who will introduce you to the fascinating world of cave ecosystems.

11:30 hrs: Enjoy a traditional kampong-style lunch in Merapoh village, savoring the rich flavours of local cuisine.

13:00 hrs: Freshen up and check out of your accommodation in Gua Musang. Depart with fond memories.








